



Conditions of Award

1. Award to be open to bona fide residents of Newfoundland and Labrador only
2. Award will be subject to application on a prescribed form to be obtained from the website: kiwanismusicfestca.wix.com/kiwaniscarbonatear and must be accompanied by an official transcript of marks for the last academic grade completed and the most current marks received in the present year.
3. Applicants must include a 250 word essay highlighting the importance of this scholarship to their continuing musical studies.
4. Applicants must be competitors in the current Annual Kiwanis Music Festival.
5. Applications must be received by the Association 2 weeks before the commencement of the current year's Festival [postmarked February 27th, 2026].
6. Award will be made at the discretion of the adjudicator.
7. Applicants must be under the age of 25 years.
8. Award shall not necessarily be made in any one year.
9. Award shall be in the amount of \$500.00.
10. Students presently or previously enrolled in advanced music studies at advanced university level are not eligible for this award.
